Liu Bolin (b. 1973, Shandong) is a Chinese contemporary artist based in Beijing, known as “the invisible man” for his Hiding in the City photographic performances.

He trained at the Shandong College of Arts (BFA, 1995) and the Central Academy of Fine Arts, Beijing (MFA, 2001). The Hiding in the City series began in 2005 as performance art after his Beijing artists’ village was demolished ahead of the 2008 Olympics.

His work has been shown in museums worldwide. He is presented by The Wall Art Gallery, Miami.
