Alberto Echegaray Guevara, also known as Cayman, is an Argentine artist born in 1970. He lives and works in Buenos Aires. His sculptures, installations, and collages explore ancient symbolism, monetary systems, and the future of transactional platforms — a hybrid of money, technology, and universal codes.

Projects seek a balance between information overload, technology, and human sensibility. Materials have included Murano blown glass, major world currencies, and noble metals such as gold, silver, platinum, and steel.

He holds graduate degrees and diplomas from Georgetown University, the École Nationale d'Administration (Paris), and Harvard Business School, and a BA in International Relations from Argentina's Military Academy and the U.S. Military Academy. He is a former cavalry officer in the Argentine army. His work has been shown at the Venice Biennale (2019, 2022) and at the Central Bank of Argentina. He is presented by The Wall Art Gallery, Miami.
