Aurélien Couput is a French visual artist born in 1979. He lives and works in New York City. He trained at the École Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts in Paris, the Haute École d'Art et de Design in Geneva, and earned an MFA in Visual Arts at Columbia University School of the Arts in 2013.

His practice includes photography, printmaking, drawing, and painting. Awards include the Prix de la Foire Internationale de Dessin (FID), the Raymond Weil International Photography Prize, and the 8th LVMH Young Artists' Award. He was featured in New American Paintings MFA Annual #99.

He is an adjunct professor in the School of the Arts at Columbia University. His work has been shown in New York, Paris, Germany, Switzerland, Japan, Spain, and China. He is presented by The Wall Art Gallery, Miami.
