## Charlotte Rose

Charlotte Rose is a Scottish pop artist born in Aberdeen in 1998. She lives and works in London. Large-scale acrylic and oil paintings on panel and canvas rework late-20th-century cigarette branding through a literary lens.

Each painting revisits the "dream" sold by companies to push poisonous goods — pairing commercial packaging with anchors from Shakespeare to Vonnegut. Series such as The Shakespeare Tobacco Company make that critique vivid and graphic.

She graduated in 2021 with a degree in creative writing. Her debut solo, *I Quit Last Week* (2021, Fitzrovia), sold out after she built an audience online. Collaborations include Coach, Jo Malone, and Gucci. She is presented by The Wall Art Gallery, Miami.
